



2023 PLAYER REGISTRATION GUIDE

Woy Woy Football Club look forward to welcoming you back for the 2023 football season, commencing April 1, 2023. This guide is for you to understand how your registration fees are used and fees for all grades.

ROLES OF EACH MEMBER BODY

Below is a quick guide to the services that each level of the Football Family is responsible for:

- Football Federation Australia (FFA):
 - Provide Play Football registration system (No longer viable)
 - All coaching resources from technical department
 - Referee education material
- Football New South Wales (FNSW):
 - FNSW Capitation
 - Champion of Champions Tournament
 - Disability programs
- Central Coast Football:
 - Administration of all local football on the Central Coast
 - Competition, Gala Days, Club Days at Plum Park along with registration campaign.
 - Draws, Results, Grading and Judiciary
 - Final series, trophies & presentations
 - Referee appointments, training, and education
 - Liaise with council for sportsground usage and upgrades to facilities
 - Maintenance and access to Plum Park
 - Competition Management (Systems, Website, Applications etc.)
 - Invests additional funds in programs (Drainage works, Defibrillators, Club Resources)
- Local Clubs:
 - Provide Playing strips, training gear and internal communication
 - Organise team rosters and grading days
 - Appoint coaches and managers
 - Player development
 - First point of call for players and parents
 - Set up fields (nets, corner posts, line marking etc.)
 - Canteen and Match Day Operations
 - Presentation days and club culture

ABOUT OUR 2023 FEES

Running Woy Woy Football Club is an inordinate undertaking. The Committee continue to work tirelessly throughout the off-season to find ways to reduce the costs of player registration. Unlike many other sporting codes, participation in football in NSW receives NO subsidisation of any description – from the state or national bodies. Clubs must ensure that the running costs are covered through registration fees, sponsorship, canteen revenue and fund-raising.

Woy Woy Football Club has a dedicated hard-working voluntary committee who put in many hours each week to keep your club operating well. Here are some of the areas that we need to spend money to keep the club operating smoothly:

- CCF registration fees & team nomination fees, which includes insurance for every registered player

 - Training Balls (the club purchases approximately 300 new footballs each year, and yes, we do reuse those from the prior year that are not worn out)

- Stationery Supplies
- Printer Rental & Printing Costs

Additionally, Central Coast Football have advised that CCF, FFA and Football NSW portion of registration fees (player registration) have increased for the 2023 season by approximately 7%.

ACTIVE KIDS GOVERNMENT REBATE

How to apply for and redeem vouchers

There are four simple steps:

1. Visit <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/campaign/active-kids> Read the Guidelines and Fact Sheets to learn about the program.
2. Visit [service.nsw.gov.au](https://www.service.nsw.gov.au) and create or login to your <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au> Account.
3. Complete an Active Kids application through your <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au> Account.
4. You will receive a voucher with a unique ID number for each child you register (available to download, print and email).

The NSW Government \$100 Active Kids Rebate will be available for eligible activities from 1st January 2023 for school children aged 4.5 years – 18 years.

LIFE PLAYER DISCOUNT/10 YEAR SERVICE - \$50.00 (Code will be supplied for Life Players after confirmation of eligibility)

SENIORS – Women and Men All Ages, M35's, M45's (Excludes Men & Women's Squad Players) For 2023 fee will be \$390.00 (Life Player Members 10 Year Service \$345.00)

DIV 1 OR PREMIER LEAGUE – Women and Men for 2023 fee will be \$470 (No Discounts)

UNDER 18 - \$255 (10 Year Service \$210.00) and/or (\$155 after AKB redemption if applicable)

JUNIORS – Under 12's to 17's – Mixed & Girls

For 2023 fees will be:

Under 12 \$230 (\$130 after \$100 AKB redemption)
Under 13 to Under 17 \$230 (\$130 after AKB redemption)

MINI ROOS (NON-COMP) – Under 5 to Under 11

PLAYER REGISTRATIONS INCLUDES A PLAYING SHIRT FOR ALL REGISTERED UNDER 5's to UNDER 11's

Under 10's to 11's
For 2023 fee will be \$210.00 (\$110 after AKB redemption)

Under 8's to 9's
For 2023 fee will be Under 8 - Under 9 - \$200.00 (\$100 after AKB redemption)

Under 5's to 7's
For 2023 fee will be \$190.00 (\$90 after AKB redemption)
PLEASE NOTE – Under 5 players are free after claiming their Active Kids Voucher

As weekly rate, your fees for 2023 look like this:

Seniors: \$16.50/week of football activities

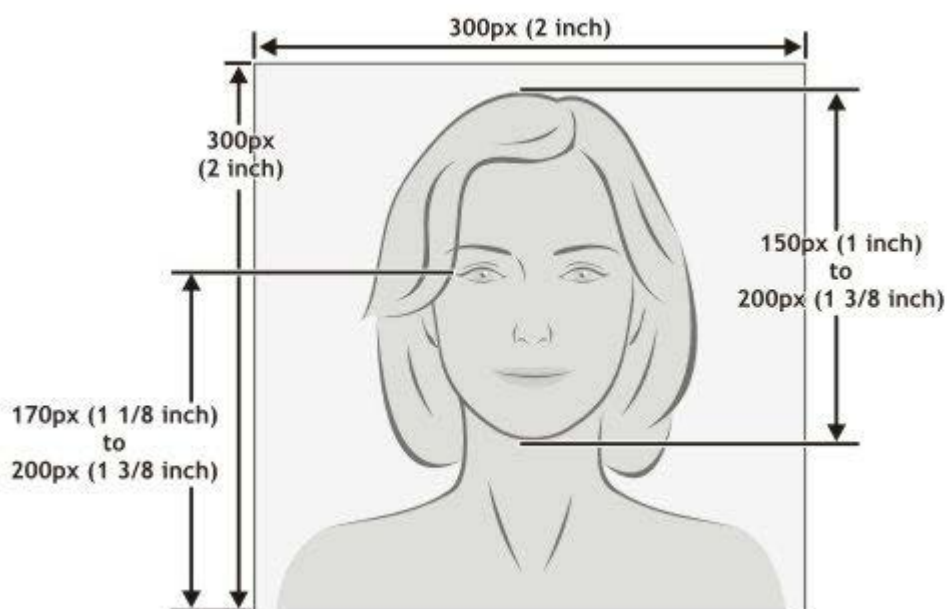
Juniors: Up to \$9.70/week of football activities

REGISTRATION SYSTEM AND REQUIREMENTS

PLAYER PHOTOS

All registered players require a passport style photo, this must be a **head shot** only. The photo must be of the player only. This must be uploaded into Central Coast's MyCompApp or your registration will be rejected. All photos are subjected to approval by the Club Administrator before registration is given final approval. If you are unsure please contact the Club Administrator for further information or assistance.



All NEW players will be required to show identification to the Club Registrar by way of a Birth Certificate, Student Card, Drivers Licence or Passport.

PLEASE NOTE – Woy Woy Football Club only takes ONLINE Payments via the Registration System. There is NO Payment Plans Available.

Woy Woy Football uses this system for their members to use. The following is the correct method of registering yourself, your son, daughter, or family member.

1. Head to ccfootball.com.au or to [REGISTRATION - CCF \(mycompapp.com\)](http://REGISTRATION - CCF (mycompapp.com))
2. Sign In using your FFA Number or the email address you used last season. If you are not sure, please DO NOT create a new account. Please contact registration@woywoyfootball.org.au and your information can be emailed to you.
3. If you are new to the area or to Football, please create a new account. You will need the following to complete an account (if you are a parent, please create your own account then link your child/ren) –
 - a. Email
 - b. FFA Number (if known)
 - c. A passport style photo (you will not be able to complete the account without one)

4. Once you have created your account or signed into your account you will be taken to the registration section where you will see your or your child's name.
5. Make sure all the information is correct then click on the Start Arrow
6. There will be four options – please select Player (Volunteer if a coach or manager or Equipment if you would like to order shorts, socks, jackets, or bags)
7. Select Woy Woy Football Club and click on the yellow arrow.
8. Select the appropriate age group for you or your child.
9. Have your Active Kids Voucher handy to redeem the \$100 discount where applicable.
10. If you are a Life Member or Life Player, please contact the Club Administrator PRIOR registering (registration@woywoyfootball.org.au) for a code.
11. If you wish to claim a Family Discount, please contact the Club Administrator (registration@woywoyfootball.org.au) for the relevant code.
12. Please ensure you register you or your child in the correct age group.
13. Payment method is ONLINE only and there are no payment plans offered by Woy Woy FC

Please Note:

From Friday 3rd March 2023 we will only take player registrations if players are needed to fill teams. Some age groups fill fast and others not so fast. Only fully registered players that have been accepted and made active by the club and will be permitted to participate in our 'Grading Process', 'Team Allocations', 'Training', 'Trial Games' and scheduled matches according to the 2023 draw. To avoid disappointment, please register and pay early.

REFUND OF REGISTRATION FEE POLICY

Refunds will NOT be considered after 5pm on Tuesday 28th February 2023.

To request a refund an "Application for Refund" form is to be completed and submitted online no later than the 5pm on Monday 27th February 2023.

Approved refunds will attract the following deductions:

- a) Administration Fee of \$50.00

Please note: The "Active Kids" portion is not refundable or transferrable. AKB can be transferred to other clubs within Central Coast Football ONLY.

COMPETITION TEAM REFEREE PAYMENT POLICY

Competition Team (Under 12-Under 17, Under 18, MAA, WAA, M35, M45 and Grade Squads) referee payments will be invoiced to the team manager or a nominated person on the first Monday of each month. The invoice fee is determined by the fee received from CCF for officials that have officiated the team's game within the given month played.

The manager or nominated person has 7 days to make payment in full into Woy Woy Football Club bank account.

If invoice is not paid as above the following action will take place:

- a) A further 5% will be added to the invoice and a new invoice resent on day 8.
- b) If payment is not received by day 14, a further 5% will be added to the day 8 invoice and resent out on day 15, furthermore Woy Woy Football Club will notify CCF's competition department that the team's next game will be forfeited due to non-payment of referees.
- c) Every 7th day that the invoice is outstanding a further 5% will be added.
- d) Woy Woy Football Club will forfeit the team's game each week until the fee is paid in full.
- e) If invoice is not paid after 30 days Woy Woy Football Club will notify CCF and have the team removed from the competition, players will not have any recourse for refunds under any circumstances.
- f) Woy Woy Football Club will make all players, registered in that given team, un-financial with CCF. Woy Woy Football Club will also request that all un-financial players' names be forwarded to Football NSW our governing Body, and request NO further registration be permitted for any player until fee is paid in full including any interest owing. Under no circumstance will part payments be accepted otherwise clause a) to f) will be adhered to.

Woy Woy Football Club will not accept payments from individual players, 1 x full payment will be accepted only.

TEAM ALLOCATION

At Woy Woy Football Club, we do our best to accommodate all registered players, however as team numbers are limited and some teams are competitive your child may miss out on a place even when fully registered, we appreciate your patience and understanding on this difficult task. If a player cannot be placed in a team, a full refund will be issued with no administrative fee charged.

Woy Woy Football Club does grade teams from Under 8 up to Under 18 when required. Teams in the Non Comp bracket (Under 8, Under 9, Under 10 and Under 11) are graded carefully and based on skill. We try to accommodate all requests where possible.

Competition teams are graded based on ability and coachability.
